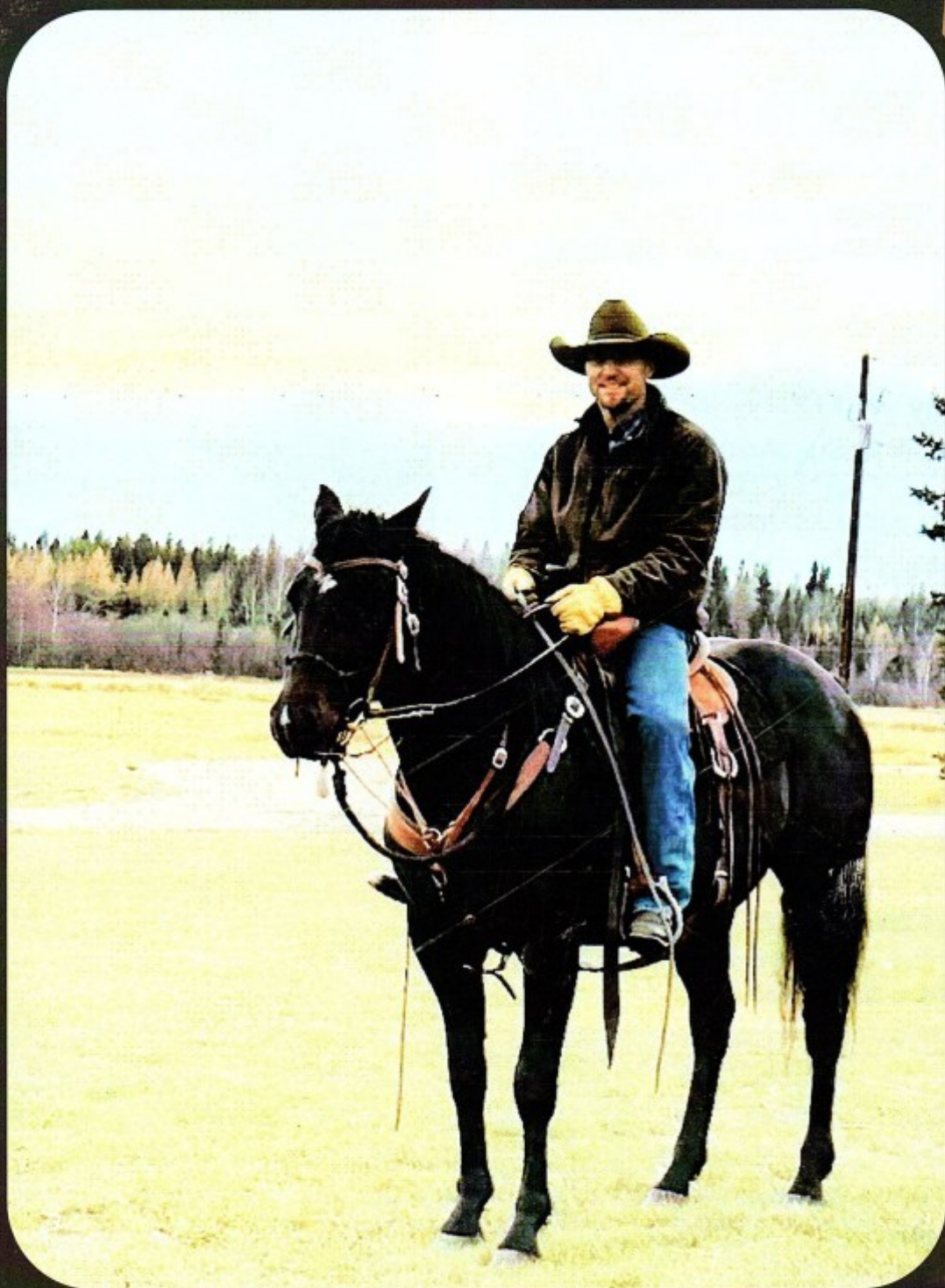

# Testimony of Jason McKenzie

I was asked by some good friends to share my story. I said "Yes, I would do it when I had time" .... well, we all know how that goes; unless we make the time to complete a project, it doesn't get done. The business of the spring and summer season and all the things I like to do have kept me from sitting down and writing my story; finally, I had to get it done! I got to thinking, if I take a couple nights off and skip riding colts for four hours, I could have my testimony written out. Maybe it will change someone's life for eternity like it did mine! So here is my testimony.... My name is Jason McKenzie and by the grace of God I've been around for 47 years now. My wife of 21 years is Bethany, and we have two fine sons, Carson (16) and Cody (13). We live on a ranch near Alder Flats, Alberta. I've been a full-time, custom saddle maker for about 25 years now. We also raise and train some Quarter horses, raise a few cows, and make hay here. I'd like to share my story about how the Lord Jesus Christ saved me. In doing this, my prayer for you is that you too will come to repent of your sin and believe on the risen Lord who came to save you from your sins. This is the single most important decision you will make while you live and breathe on earth. If you are already a follower of the Lord Jesus Christ, I hope you will be encouraged to "lay aside every weight (everything that is slowing you down or stopping you from effectively serving Jesus Christ), and the sin which does so easily beset us (or hold us up), and let us run with patience the race that is set before us. Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith, who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God" Hebrews 12:1-2.

I was born in Edmonton, Alberta Canada in 1978. The second child of Bryan and Linda McKenzie. Both of my parents grew up in homes without Christ and where alcohol was used and abused by their parents. My Dad grew up near Rock Glen, Saskatchewan and was searching for truth and peace as a young man about 20 years old. Someone gave him a booklet about the love of God. This interested him, and while he was on a solo canoe trip floating the North Saskatchewan river, camping on sand bars, and reading the New Testament portion of God's Word, he realized he was in fact one of the sinners Jesus Christ loved and died to save.



He made his decision to repent and follow Jesus Christ. My Dad was an example of faith to me and many others. My mom grew up near Bon Accord, Alberta; she had an aunt that would send the family gospel texts and written messages about the goodness of God and the new life he offers to all that come to Him by faith. They all thought little of her until one day the pressures and emptiness of life without Christ brought my mother to call up her aunt and start asking questions about God, eternal life, and forgiveness. She came to the understanding that salvation is a free gift that a person can receive through repentance towards God and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. She made her choice and the Lord saved her. Dad and Mom met in Edmonton. They were married in Edmonton in 1976 and decided they wanted as many children as the Lord would give them. They loved and lived sacrificially to raise us up "in the nurture and admonition of the Lord" as best they could. The family grew to a total of twelve children. I remember my dad reading the Bible to us at night as we lay in our beds. Please don't ever underestimate the power of the Word of God! There is no other book on this earth like it! "For the word of God is quick (full of life! living! alive!), and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. Neither is there any creature (or person) that is not manifest (clearly revealed) in His sight; but all things are naked and opened unto the eyes of Him with whom we have to do" (Hebrews 4:12, 13). As my dad read the Bible, some nights all of us would fall asleep. But one night, when I was seven years old, I remember well, lying there as Dad read from the book of Revelation in the Bible. As he finished up chapter 20, he read these words:



“ And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.”

That night I couldn't sleep. I distinctly remember lying there thinking about eternity and the two options as to where I could spend eternity. The devil, the beast, and the false prophet will be cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, and shall be tormented day and night forever and ever. The reality of those words “forever and ever” struck me hard that night along with the words, “And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.” As I lay there, I thought of myself in an eternal place of torment and separation from God and all that is good, pure, lovely, honest, just, and holy. I realized the seriousness of my sins and the eternal consequences of dying without Christ as my Lord and Savior. Only the names of those who have repented of their sins and believed on the Lord Jesus Christ have their names written in the Book of Life. It was then I understood for the first time that Jesus Christ was my only hope for salvation from my sin, and He alone could save me from the horrors of the final judgment and eternal lake of fire. God is the God of perfect love and perfect justice. He hates and judges sin. He loves sinners like you and me and died to save you and me

I recall asking the Lord to forgive me for my sins, thanking Him for dying in my place, and placing my trust in Him alone for salvation. At that point my fears were gone, the Spirit of the living God immediately indwelt me (Ephesians 1:13,14), and I was sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise which is the earnest (guarantee) of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of His glory! I know that happened, not because of what I felt, but because God's Word says it happened. I slept well that night knowing I was saved. 1 John 5:13 says, “These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.” After my salvation I was baptized when I was eleven years old in obedience to the Word of God and out of a desire to please, honor, obey, and identify with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection, and to walk in newness of life! I would like to point out that the Lord is giving you the opportunity now to repent (have a change of heart and mind) and trust in Him alone to save you. When Jesus died on the cross, He said, “It is finished”, and He meant it. The work that saves is done. Will you turn to Christ for salvation? There is nothing you can do to earn salvation from your sin. We are saved by grace through faith. What is faith? Faith is placing your confidence and trust in the Lord Jesus Christ.

As I grew up, I experienced the struggle between my flesh (the sin nature we are born with) and the Spirit of the Lord in me. I was weakened at times by selfishly pursuing the pleasures of sin, watching movies I knew I shouldn't watch, by fulfilling my own selfish desires, and walking in disobedience to God's will. I was helped and strengthened by dealing with sin in my life, spending time with other believers, reading the Word of God and obeying the Lord, and by the good Bible teaching I was blessed with. In service, just like in salvation, our gracious Heavenly Father allows us to choose to follow, willingly obey, and sacrificially live for Him. I love Him for giving me this choice. You see, the Lord wants your heart - your willing service. Love is the motivator in the born-again Christian's life! There were definitely times in my life that I failed the Lord and yielded to flesh and sinned against Him. Once you are saved, “God deals with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?”. This chastening is training; sometimes it involves disciplinary correction. (Hebrews 12: 1-29). This process is not enjoyable at the time, but it results in peace and righteousness in a born-again believer's life. There is nothing better than living in harmony with the Lord and walking daily with Him. This I do know! What God has for you is far better than anything the Christless world system can offer you!

## The Cowboy as a Symbol of Christian Faith



The One who made you and the entire world knows everything about you, loves you, and proved it by laying down His life for you. He has a perfect plan for your life. You can discover that plan by daily following the Lord's directives. He will lead you by His written Word and His Spirit. The one will never contradict the other. Psalms 119:105 says, "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path." In a world system where there is so much deception that people are asking "What is reality?", we must know His Word. The verse I was given by the man that baptized me at eleven years of age after I was saved was this, "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the Word of Truth" (1 Timothy 2:15).

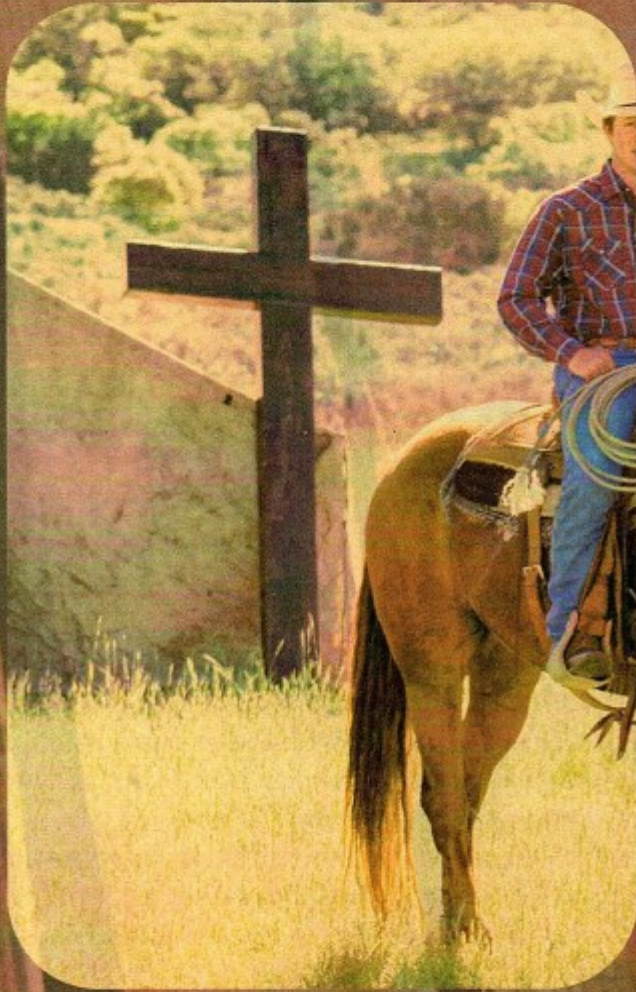
As I obeyed this scriptural instruction over the last 40 years, I have found that my confidence in God, my faith, has become stronger and stronger. I love Him more and more as my understanding of Him through His word is increased. When I have gone through storms in this life, His Word and the sure hope it contains is an anchor for my "soul, both sure and steadfast, and which entereth into that within the veil (the presence of God) where the forerunner is for us entered, even Jesus, made a high priest forever after the order of Melchizedek" (Hebrews 6:19,20). Just as sure as my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ is seated at the right hand of the throne of God, I am sure that when I die or when the trumpet of the Lord sounds and the Lord Himself comes for his own (1 Thessalonians 4:14-18), I will go to be with Him for eternity. Where will you spend eternity? There are two options: Heaven or Hell. We each have one life of which none of us knows the length. In this life we all make our eternal choice based on what we do with Jesus Christ. We either accept Him or reject Him. Jesus is God manifest (revealed) in the flesh 1 Timothy 3:16. God has clearly revealed Himself to you through the creation of the world and the things that He made so that you are without excuse. No one on earth can say that they didn't know of the living and true God. Romans chapter 3 makes that clear. Repent of your sins, believe on the risen Lord Jesus Christ, and be saved to live a new life now. "Behold now is the accepted time, behold now is the day of salvation" (2 Corinthians 6:2). Turn to Jesus Christ; He is calling you. Tomorrow may be too late.

And to my brothers and sisters in Christ I write this...We have a God-given responsibility to share the good news of Jesus Christ with those the Lord puts on our path of life (Matthew 27:18-20). Allow the Spirit to lead you to share the gospel with these precious people. **THINK MORE ABOUT THE MESSAGE THE LORD WANTS YOU TO SHARE WITH OTHERS THAN HOW IT WILL BE RECEIVED.** This has helped me tremendously to faithfully communicate the truth of the Word of God. Always remember His promise to you as a believer. "And lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen

(Matthew 27:20). If you want to experience the incomparable joys of being used by the Lord, having Him work in and through you, you must learn to say "Yes, Lord". Since He is Lord, He is the Supreme Authority of all-- and over my life specifically. For the love of Christ constraineth us (gets a grip on us), for we thus judge, that if one died for all, then we've all died; and we which live should not henceforth (or from this time forward) live unto ourselves (do our own thing in life) but unto Him who died for us and rose again. We owe Him our lives, our hearts, our all!

Paul's letters to the different churches were written to stress the importance of understanding the mystery of God. After Saul's (Paul) encounter with the Lord, this knowledge was revealed to him. In Eph 3:1-2, we learn that Paul was devoted to being a witness to the gentiles all because of the grace the Lord had showed him, "For this reason, I Paul the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles, if indeed you have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which was given to me for you". The next verses of 3 & 4, Paul tells us that God made His mystery known to him and wants us to understand this mystery through his attained knowledge. We learn in Eph 6:19 that Paul's desire was to open his mouth boldly to make known the mystery of the gospel... could you imagine the impact that this would have if this was the desire of all believers!! Col 1:26-29, "The mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations but now has been revealed to His saints. A mystery is something we have to search out to find the truth (the Bible actually tells us to search the scriptures). God has to reveal this mystery to us, just as he did for Paul. 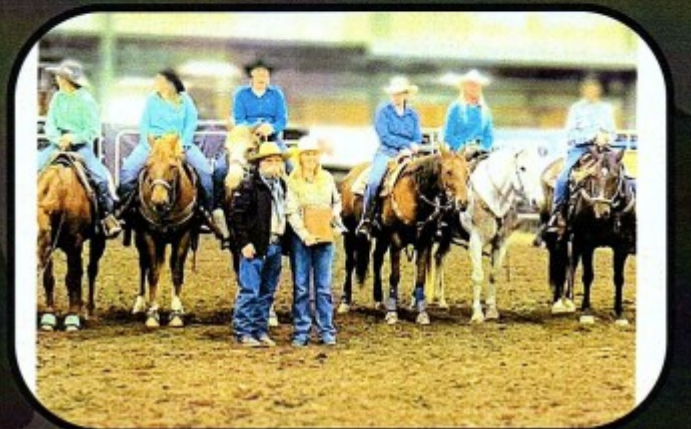

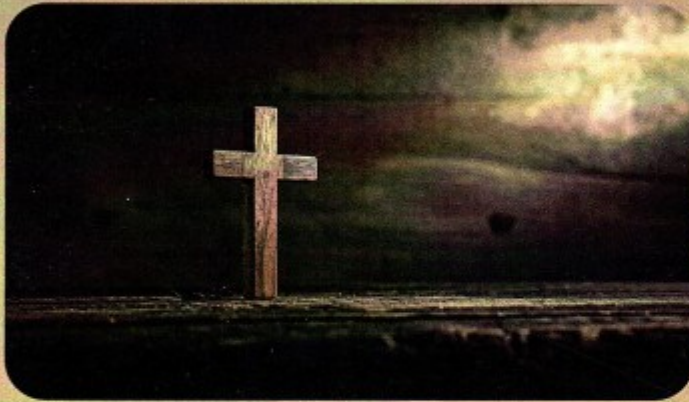
